

HOW TO OBTAIN A BIRTH CERTIFICATE

The cost of a birth certificate from the City of Hornell is \$10, payable in cash, check or money order [made out to "CITY OF HORNELL"].

The Office of City Clerk has birth certificates only for those born at St. James Mercy Hospital or at home within the municipal boundaries of the City. Those born at the old Bethesda Hospital are on file with the North Hornell Village Clerk.

According to New York State law, there are only two ways to obtain a birth certificate: either in person at the City Clerk's office, or through the mail. Those eligible to get a birth certificate are those named on the certificate, or their parent, or their legal guardian, or their designated attorney [proof required for parent, legal guardian, and designated attorney].

If in person: Show identification. PLEASE LET US KNOW IF THIS CERTIFICATE IS BEING USED TO OBTAIN A PASSPORT.

If via mail: Write a brief request stating your name, date of birth, location of birth, and your relationship to the person named on the certificate. PLEASE LET US KNOW IF THIS CERTIFICATE IS BEING USED TO OBTAIN A PASSPORT. Also provide photocopied identification [e.g., a driver's license], along with payment and a self-addressed, stamped envelope. If there are no problems or omissions, birth certificates are mailed back the same day they are received.
