

Hours at the Composting Facility are 7 a.m.-5 p.m. Thursdays through Sundays, excluding holidays. The Facility is closed Mondays through Wednesdays for the manufacture of mulch.

Area residents can drop off yard waste at the Facility. Soon, free mulch compost will be available – in limited quantities – for use in residential gardens. An announcement will be made when mulch compost is available.

Residents of the City of Hornell, Village of North Hornell, and the Town of Hornellsville can drop off material at the Facility at no charge if they have identification that proves their addresses.

Non-residents and contractors must pay \$1.50 per bag or \$10 per pickup or trailer load of not more than five (5) cubic yards.

No cash is accepted at the Compost Facility. Instead, non-residents and contractors who want to drop off brush must pay with a valid punch-type ticket that can be purchased at Hornell City Hall and Hornell Do It Best. Tickets can be purchased in quantities of \$15 and \$30.

The Compost Facility accepts grass, leaves, and brush only. It will not take stumps or trunks larger than 12 inches in diameter, nor brush more than four (4) feet in length. Again, no more than five (5) cubic yards per load will be accepted.
